

## **SUBMISSION FOR DEMOCRACY REVIEW**

This CLP resolves to send the following as a submission to the Labour Party Democracy Review:

1. The election of the Leader of the Cornwall Labour Party shall be elected by One-Member-One-Vote involving all Labour members living in Cornwall.
2. Elected representatives should communicate regularly with members; and a range of practical measures introduced to help members participate – training, funding to attend events, etc.
3. There should be opportunities for all local members to participate democratically in the creation of the Labour manifesto for local elections.
4. The Local Campaign Forum shall be known in Cornwall as the Cornwall Labour Party, and this shall continue its co-ordinating role across constituency parties and local government and shall establish its own internal democratic structures as appropriate.
5. The Cornwall Labour Party shall hold an annual conference, open to all local members, to debate such matters as have been submitted formally from constituency parties.
